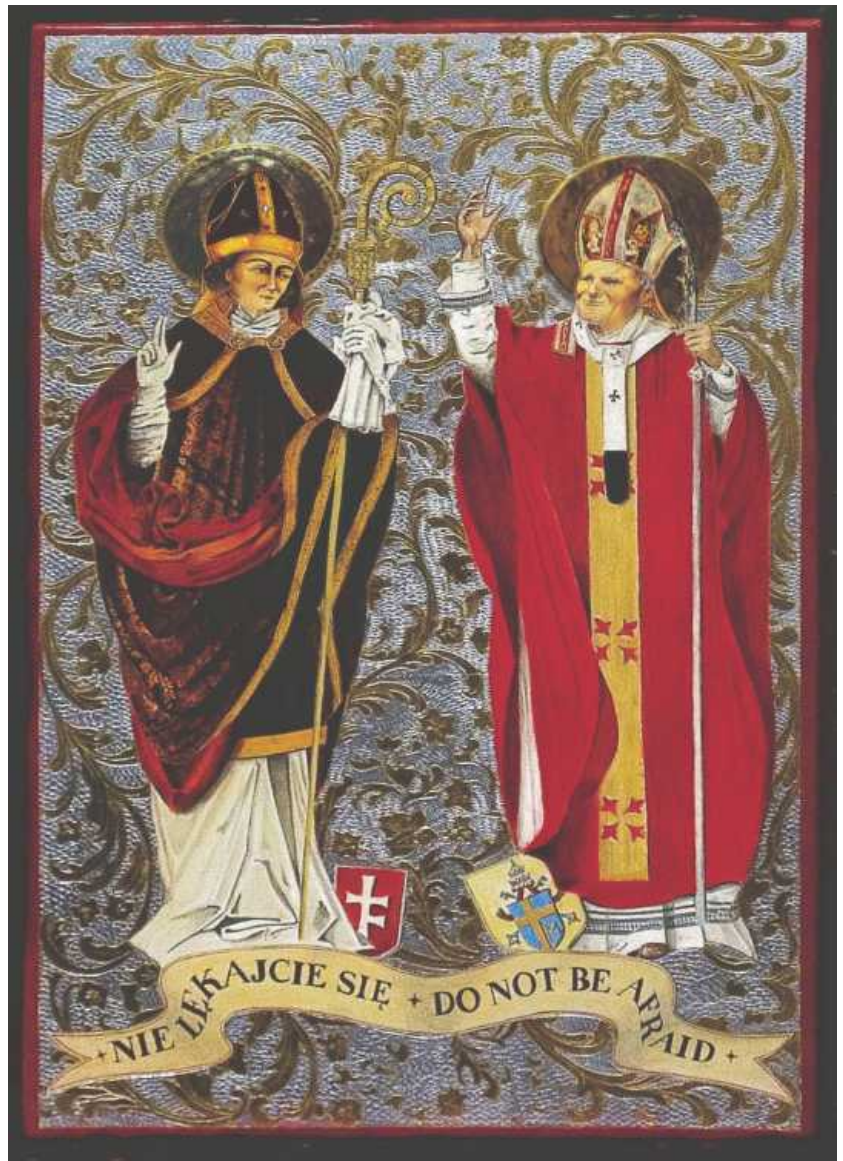

FESTIVAL TIME!

In less than two weeks we open our doors to thousands of guests for the annual Polish Festival. Parishioners have been pinching pierogi, stuffing cabbage, making kielbasa from scratch, and pulling out the old recipe cards for favorite home bakery. Others are looking around for just the right touches for the gift baskets (we're famous for them!) raffled away, and I hope everyone is going out of their way to sell a couple extra books of sweepstakes tickets.

There is not a single parish activity outside of Mass that involves everybody as much as this one. Although it is hard work, there is lots of fun to be had as well. At the end of it all, the hundreds of workers and volunteers are tired yet grateful they could have a chance to do something good for their parish. Remember, all the money we make during the festival pays for our heat in the winter. You want a warm church in January? Sell tickets in September!

I try to steel myself against any sadness as I prepare to celebrate this festival for the last time as your priest and pastor. Although I have already had a number of "The last time I'll..." moments, there is a special place in my heart for this festival. It was years ago, in the summer of 1992, that Fr. Alcuin asked me to find a good partner in the parish with whom to recreate the festival, which he wanted to grow into something more. I asked Richard Konisiewicz, who agreed and put his whole heart and soul into it. I remember the planning meetings, the organizing, the cajoling, the hard work — and the prayers — that made this the biggest and best Polish festival we could possibly pull off.

All three TV networks showed up to cover the story, so our kitchen was swamped by the huge number of people showing up to eat. By the end of Saturday, the head cook wanted to cancel the meal for Sunday and just have dancing. He said, "But Father, we have no more food!" I answered, "Then let's get cooking! I'll drive to Chicago or Detroit overnight if I have to, but there's got to be some good Polish food to provide for our guests." So, they shopped, cooked, and provided an abundant and amazing feast.

Over the years since then, the festival has evolved. The menu has changed a bit, but we still offer a tremendous variety, and it's all home made. The rooms look a bit different, but there is still the feeling of being transported to another place, another moment. The polka music is just as lively, and the school kids are still some of our best ambassadors. Of course, the church looks very different than it did in 1992! But some of the best moments are when old friends run into each other unexpectedly, starting their conversations with, "Remember when...?"

Someday soon, I will be part of that "remember when" crowd. The young children from 1992 are now asking me to officiate their weddings, to baptize their children. If I get a chance to visit in the future, I will always be proud of the many moments of community and family — like the one coming up in a couple of weeks. Let's make it the best one ever!

Głuchy telefon

Chyba wszyscy pamiętamy dziecięcą zabawę w „głuchy telefon”. Osoba stojąca pierwsza w szeregu zaczyna mówiąc na ucho swojemu sąsiadowi jakiegoś słowo czy zdanie, a ta mówi następnej, i tak po kolei, aż do ostatniej osoby zamykającej szereg. Ostatni w szeregu mówi głośno to słowo czy zdanie. Wtedy bardzo często okazuje się, że to ostatnie zdanie jest bardzo różne od tego wypowiedzianego na początku. Dla przykładu ze zdania: „Ala ma kota” powstaje zdanie „Ala ma kaca”. Ta różnica jest okazją do śmiechu.

Nie tak dawno, może więcej niż tydzień temu, jedna z parafianek zadzwoniła do mnie prosząc o wyjaśnienie, co stanie się z ojcem Michałem i ze mną po odejściu z parafii św. Stanisława, ponieważ słyszała wiele sprzecznych ze sobą informacji i chciała skonfrontować je z tym, co ja powiem. Jej informacje zawierały elementy prawdziwe, podobnie jak zdanie „Ala ma kaca” nosi pewne podobieństwa ze zdaniem wyjściowym. Jednak oprócz tego słyszała inne, po części sprzeczne ze sobą i nieprawdziwe informacje. Nie sądzą, że ktoś miał złą intencję przekazując je dalej. Myślę raczej, że te inne opinie, czy raczej elementy nieprawdziwe w nich są owocem niezrozumienia czy przesłyszenia się. Dlatego w tej refleksji chciałem sprostować informacje na temat przyszłości o. Michała i mojej.

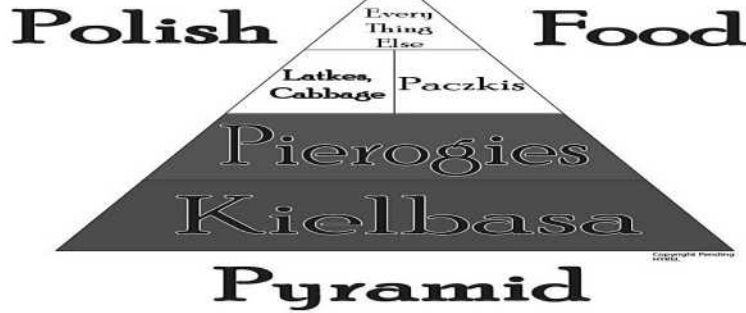

Leslie; innym jest kapelan szpitala. Także i ja sam po powrocie z Polski mam zamieszkać w tym nowym domu. Przypominam, że jest to nowy dom, który dopiero trzeba urządzić. Na razie trudno powiedzieć z całą pewnością, kiedy będzie gotowy do użytku jako klasztor. Mamy nadzieję, że jeszcze jesienią tego roku. Ja na pewno nie dołączę się wcześniej niż za rok, ponieważ proces uzyskania zielonej karty potrwa do roku czasu. Przez ten rok będę w Polsce. Jak na razie nie wiem, co będę robił przez ten rok. Dowiem się po powrocie do Polski. Bilety mam na 12 października.

Nowy klasztor nie będzie przyłączony do parafii, jako to ma miejsce w Cleveland. Nie będzie tam nawet kościoła do publicznego użytku. Będzie tylko kaplica z Najświętszym Sakramentem do użytku wewnętrznego.

Moim miejscem pracy będzie przytułek dla bezdomnych. Do tej pory, przez ostatnie 20 lat, ten dom prowadzony był przez o. Błażeja Karasia, franciszkanina z prowincji, do której należą także o. Len, o. Michał i Br. Justin. Ponieważ o. Błażej skończył już 80 lat, potrzeba, aby ktoś pomagał mu, a później zastąpił. Na propozycję odpowiedziałem tak.

Bardzo proszę o modlitwę w mojej intencji oraz tych, dla których będę pracował.
