BEFORE THE COCK CROWS TWICE....

- Before the phone rings twice.....
- Before the second phone call....
- Before the second TV commercial airs....
- Before the second cup of coffee....
- Before the second conversation of the day....
- Before the second facebook visit....
- Before the second text message....
- Before the second time we hear "a poor Church for the poor"
-you will deny me three times.....**

From the moment our eyes are opened temptation awaits the chance to distract us from good. We live in a world where doubt is sown into the atmosphere by the media, by unbelievers, by agnostics and atheists— all with such ease. This same doubt penetrates our own ranks too frequently as we experience the pessimism of our own parishioners complain about this or that person, about this priest or that priest, this bishop or that bishop, this nun or that nun, about this rule or that rule and on and on. Most surprising is how little faith we see when we are confronted with values that clash with our own. An example is how we say we believe in the working of the Holy Spirit during the conclave....but when a pope is elected who rubs us the wrong way, the Holy Spirit seems to disappear from the formula. We don't want to accept that the Holy Spirit may have wanted to tell us something we might not want hear. We don't want to accept that the prayers of the cardinals and billion plus Catholics around the world were answered. We don't want to accept a challenge to the values we think are correct, despite of what the Church has determined in her wisdom. Is this just another form of denial, ignoring the very Spirit which we should be embracing? Do we need to add "before the second ballot of the conclave" to our list of sins of denial?

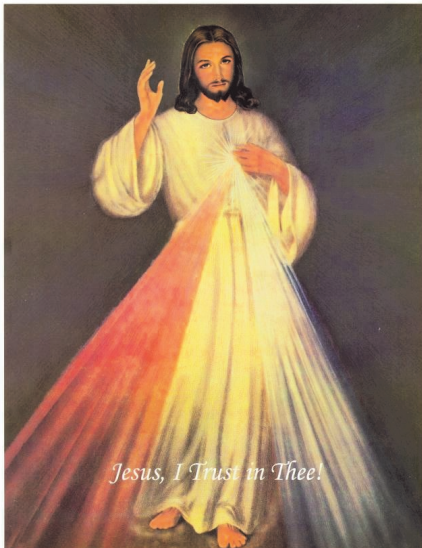
"When we don't proclaim Jesus Christ, we proclaim the worldliness of the devil, the worldliness of the demon" ..Words from the first homily of Pope Francis. "When we walk without the Cross, when we build without the Cross and when we proclaim Christ without the Cross, we are not disciples of the Lord. We are worldly. We may be bishops, priests, cardinals, popes, all of the aforementioned...but we are not disciples of the Lord."more of his words during that first homily as supreme pontiff.

As the Holy Father said during his first hours in office, it is not he who is the center of the church—JESUS is. He is simply one of the servants. His references to simplicity and to the poor have rattled many cages. Yet, are these concerns not the same as those of Jesus? His chosen name "Francis" reflects these concerns, but even St. Francis of Assisi would be upset if anyone chose to follow his words over those of Christ. For St. Francis and for Pope Francis the only words that matter are those found in the Gospel. That both chose to preach that Gospel through a prism of humility and poverty is nothing new, but it does not sit well with our world where consumerism and power and materialism are the opiates which hold up firmly the veil from the Truth. These aren't novel ideas. Bl. John Paul held these same ideals as did Pope Benedict. It is just that now we have a pope who is speaking in laymen's terms and the world hates to hear the Truth shouted so clearly. Maybe the Holy Spirit thought that we needed to open our ears and use our hands and feet and hearts for a change - living the Eucharist. Remember what was said as the ashes were placed on your forehead: "Repent and live the Gospel." Denying Jesus is done so easily during our daily life. Yet, as he forgave Peter, he will always forgive us.
