TAKE A BEAR, HELP RESUCITATE A KING

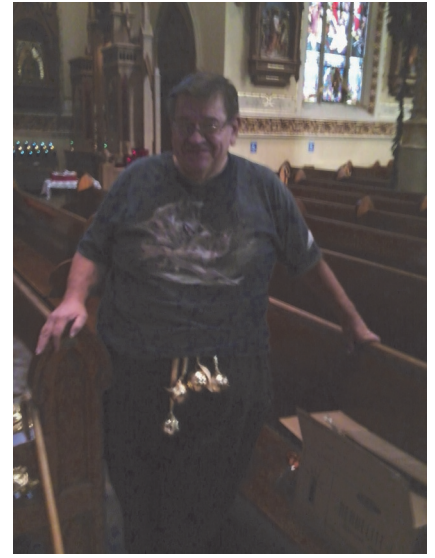

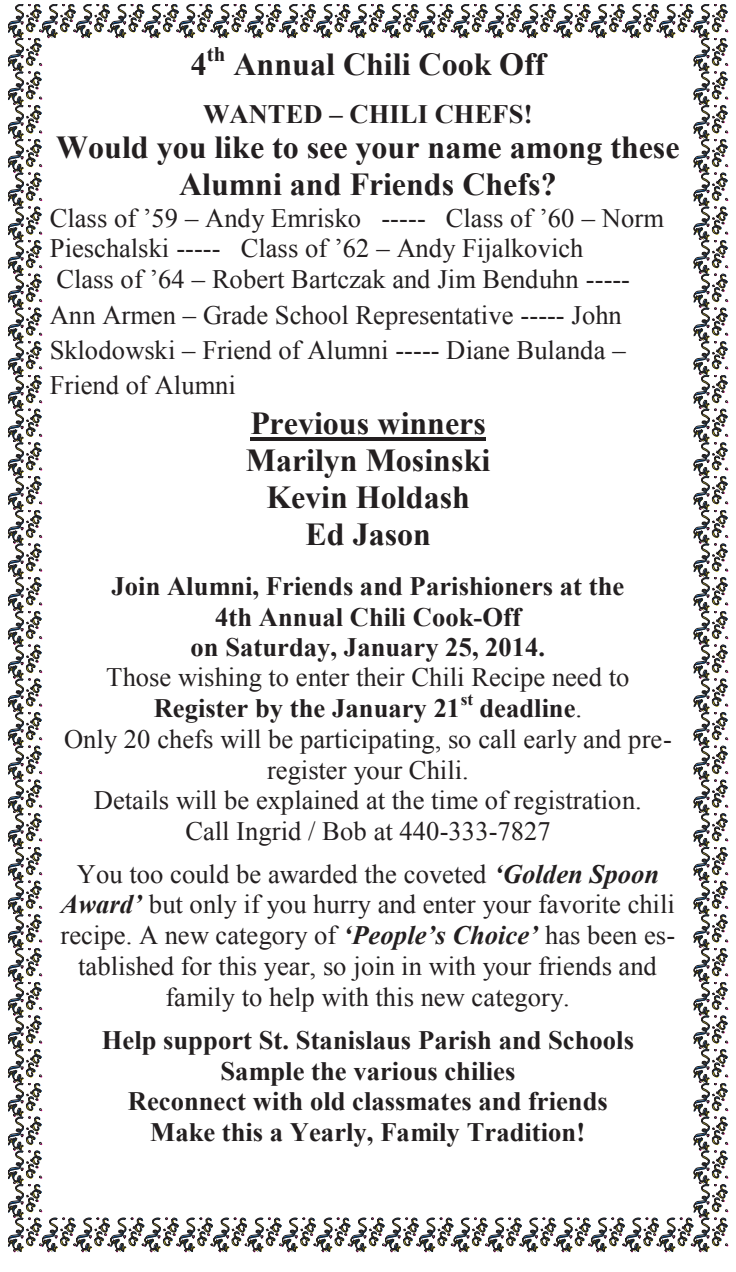
