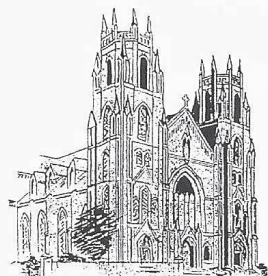


INFANTS / TODDLERS OF SLAVIC VILLAGE

Sw. Stanislaw Szczepanowski. Kan.: 8 wrzesnia, 1253 r.

ok. 1030-79, Biskup krakowski od 1072; późniejsza tradycja wywodzi go ze wsi Szczepanów, stąd nazywany Szczepanowskim a. ze Szczepanowa, ale rzeczywiste jego pochodzenie nie jest znane. Niewątpliwym faktem historycznym jego życia jest zatarg, w jaki popadł z Bolesławem (zob.) Śmiałym.

Reszta jest hipotezą a. legendą powstałą znacznie później, zapewne pod wpływem głośnego konfliktu św. Tomasza (zob.) Becketa z królem ang. Henrykiem II, sporu zakończonego zamordowaniem arcybiskupa w katedrze kanterberyjskiej.

Nie jest też całkiem pewne nawet to, czy biskupa krakowskiego skazano na śmierć, czy, jak twierdzi Gall, na truncatio membrorum (częstą w śrdw. karę obcięcia prawej dłoni i lewej stopy a. na odwrót).

Uderzenie tępym narzędziem w tył głowy, którego ślad nosi czaszka w relikwiarzu św. Stanisława w katedrze wawelskiej (zbadana w 1963), mogło równie prawdop. spowodować śmierć, jak i przejściowe ogłuszenie.

Autorem legendy o św. Stanisławie był Wincenty Kadłubek, który w swej Kronice, napisanej niemal w półtora wieku później, ukazuje pasję w kościele na Skałce, napad w świątyni, poćwiartowanie zwłok, orły strzegące ciała i cudowne zrośnięcie się członków.

Jeszcze później narodziła się legenda o wskrzeszeniu Piotrowina (zob.). Kult św. Stanisława, który ogarnął cały kraj w 2. poł. XIII i pocz. XIV w., odegrał ważną rolę historyczną jako czynnik kształtowania się ideologii zjednoczenia państwa polskiego rozbitego na dzielnicowe księstwa.

Był to pierwszy święty polski; w XI i XII w. kościół polski zadowalać się musiał świętymi czeskimi, Waclawem i Wojciechem. Zatarg św. Stanisława z królem stał się tematem lit. (Długosz, Kallimach, Mikołaj Sęp-Szarzyński, Szymon Szymonowie, Julian Ursyn Niemcewicz, zob. też Bolesław: Śmiały).
