**MASS MOB COMING TO ST. STANS**

The next Cleveland 'MASS MOB' will be held on Sunday, October 5, 2014 at the 11:30 AM Mass here at the Shrine Church of St. Stanislaus. This popular movement, which began in Buffalo and has spread throughout the country, borrows from modern fads and uses of social media to promote a most worthwhile cause—people's spirituality. "MASS MOBS" are based on the 'flash mob' concept, where people use every sort of social media to advertise and promote an event or location on a certain date. The result is a much larger crowd than usual showing up to patronize a worthy business or event and getting people to participate in or go someplace which they might otherwise not.



Similarly, "MASS MOBBERS" are invited to come to a particular church for a particular Mass. The churches chosen by the "MASS MOB" committee are those identified as being historically or architecturally significant. Many also happen to be located in once bustling parts of the city whose neighborhoods and congregations no longer boast overflowing numbers so the benefit to them is also appreciated. Cleveland's first "MASS MOB" in March at St. Casimir's welcomed a 'flash' crowd of over 800 people!

Completed in 1891, our Shrine Church of St. Stanislaus is easily one of the most beautiful and impressive Gothic structures in Ohio and the entire region. With a fine music program and notable artifacts, including a first class relic of St. John Paul II, it is a destination for pilgrim groups from across the country. Tours of the church will be available after the Mass and the Shrine's annual Polish Festival will be taking place in the adjacent Social Center and is open to all afterwards as well..

In keeping with the festive atmosphere, those attending the Mass will be inspired by the sounds of the brass and tympani along with our organ. We hope many people will come to join us and be touched by the experience and beauty so as to leave us at the end of the day and make the city a better place. God works through many channels...the beauty and spiritual gifts found here at the Shrine are such that are available to all who come here to pray or simply be inspired as often as they are able.
