Z życia Kościoła

Zmarła autorka pieśni „Czarna Madonna”

W wieku 63 lat zmarła 29 września Alicja Gołaszewska, jasnogórska organistka, kompozytorka, dyrygentka. To jej zawdzięczamy znaną niemal na całym świecie pieśń „Czarna Madonna”, czy też „600 lat Maryjo z nami jesteś” i wiele innych utworów maryjnych. Do 2010 r. skomponowała około 300 piosenek i pieśni ewangelicznych. Ponadto opracowała na trzy lub cztery głosy około 100 tradycyjnych pieśni i piosenek religijnych.

Synod Biskupów

W dniach **5-19 października** w Rzymie odbywa się **III Nadzwyczajne Zgromadzenie Ogólnego Synodu Biskupów**. Przedmiotem obrad Zgromadzenia są *“Wyzwania duszpasterskie wobec rodziny w kontekście ewangelizacji”*. Pierwszy Synod Biskupów, jaki zwołuje papież Franciszek, został poświęcony rodzinie. Głównym jego celem jest odnowa duszpasterstwa rodzin. Kościół szukać będzie odpowiedzi na jeden z największych współczesnych problemów, jakim jest kryzys rodziny. W samej Polsce – jednym z najbardziej katolickich krajów – rozpada się już co trzecie małżeństwo. W 2013 r. na 181 tys. zawartych małżeństw orzeczono 66 tys. rozwodów. Pod względem liczby rozwodów zajmujemy piąte miejsce w Europie, a w ciągu ostatnich 10 lat ich liczba wzrosła o 42 proc. Wyprzedzamy już wiele krajów, np. we Włoszech czy w Irlandii procent rozwodów jest o połowę mniejszy. Zachęcamy wszystkich do modlitwy w intencji Synodu!

Wzrost liczby nowych powołań kapłańskich

804 nowych alumnów rozpocznie w Polsce w nowym roku akademickim przygotowanie do kapłaństwa co oznacza wzrost o 3 proc. w stosunku do roku poprzedniego. Natomiast ogółem we wszystkich seminariach i na wszystkich rocznikach przygotowuje się do kapłaństwa ok. 3850 alumnów. Najliczniejszym polskim seminarium jest nadal Wyższe Seminarium Duchowne w Tarnowie, gdzie kształcą się ok. 200 kleryków, w tym 36 młodych mężczyzn rozpoczęło właśnie formację do kapłaństwa na pierwszym roku.

Nie będzie komunii dla rozwiedzionych

Papież nie zmieni zasad dotyczących dopuszczania do komunii rozwodników żyjących w związkach niesakramentalnych. Ujawnił to ordynariusz Cordoby bp Demetrio Fernandez. „Zapytaliśmy samego Papieża i on odpowiedział, że osoba, która zawarła małżeństwo w Kościele, rozwiodła się i zawarła związek cywilny, nie może przystępować do sakramentów” – relacjonuje bp Fernandez w wywiadzie dla dziennika Diario Cordoba. „Ojciec Święty powiedział, że «zostało to ustanowione przez Jezusa Chrystusa i Papież nie może tego zmienić»”. Ordynariusz Cordoby zdecydował się opowiedzieć o tej rozmowie z Franciszkiem, „ponieważ ludzie niekiedy twierdzą, że wszystko się zmieni. Są jednak rzeczy, które zmienić się nie mogą. Kościół odpowiada przed swym Panem, który wciąż żyje”.

Młoda mama oddała życie, by urodzić dziecko!

24-letnia Ashley Bridges zdecydowała, że woli umrzeć niż zaszkodzić dziecku lub dokonać aborcji. Odrzuciła chemioterapię, która mogłaby ją ocalić przed śmiercią na raka kości. Bridges dowiedziała się o swojej chorobie, gdy była w 10. tygodniu ciąży z córką Paisley. Lekarze naciskali, by natychmiast rozpoczęła chemioterapię. To oznaczałoby jednak nieuchronną śmierć jej dziecka. Bridges zdecydowanie odrzuciła taką możliwość – nie chciała ocalić swojego życia zabijając własną córkę. Rak okazał się śmiertelny i Bridges zdaniem lekarzy nie przeżyje nawet roku od porodu. Bridges nie żałuje, że wybrała życie swojej córki zamiast swojego. Kilka dni temu Bridges otrzymała informację od lekarzy, że rak kości nie zaatakował jeszcze jej nóg, tak jak wcześniej się spodziewano. Co więcej nie urósł także guz w jej głowie. Diagnoza wciąż jest ponura, jednak Bridges wciąż ma nadzieję, że będzie mogła być ze swoimi dziećmi choć nieco dłużej.
