WHY ORGAN RESTORATION?

First of all, thanks goes to the parishioners who have already stepped forward to contribute to our newly established organ restoration fund. As of this date we have about \$4,000 - a good start toward our goal of \$100,000 needed to match the grant offered to us by the Geis Foundation. We have two years to reach that goal. Only \$96,000 more to go!!! Onward and upward!

The current pipe organ was installed after the 'tornado' of 1909. It was designed by the SCHUELKE firm of Wisconsin. What we do not know is whether or not it existed prior to that date (removed from another church) or custom made for St. Stanislaus. What we do know is that the

early 20th century saw quite a bit of experimenting as to 'how to build a better mousetrap' with regards to pipe organ building. In the case of SCHUELKE organs of that period, the 'better' mousetrap proved to be not as good as hoped, the result being the rebuilding of many of that firm's organs over the decades, or the scrapping of them entirely. In our case the route chosen to rehab the instrument is one of 'updating' the mechanical system, replacing some of the proven inadequacies with more reliable technology. Already in 2002 the console (keyboards and brains of the instrument) were restored. Now, under the direction of the JAMES LEEK ORGAN COMPANY of Oberlin the guts of the organ will be overhauled to allow the instrument to be brought back to its full potential and glory once again.

Over the past 100 years of its existence the instrument was maintained as needed and partially re-wired and re-leathered by the Dad's Club members (the 1980's). During the church renovations in 1997-98 quite a number of ranks of pipes were damaged, ultimately to be restored by the HOLTkamp COMPANY, the same firm who did some work on the instrument back in the 1930's. All the band-aids over the past century now have led to the necessary exhaustive operation with the finished result being an instrument worthy of this majestic edifice for centuries to come.

I know that to many it might not seem as drastic a need as I make it sound. Fortunately I try my best to mask the inadequacies and absolute shortcomings of our organ as well as I am able. The amount of pipes which no longer speak or couple is amazing. The cross-ciphering and the inability to tune correctly is approaching the unbearable. These are the reasons we need to 'admit the patient' now before it reaches the point of no return. A new instrument of this caliber would cost well over a million dollars. Our efforts to correct and maintain our current organ are more within our reach. We all know a building of this sort never has small repair bills...and never will. If we intend on passing this treasure on to future generations we must step up to the plate now and keep whittling away at the various projects. As responsible stewards of this spiritual and cultural gem we have no choice but to regularly address things of this nature. Thanks to everyone who has or will contribute to this particular endeavor! 11 listopada Święto Niepodległości**



„Polski my naród, polski ród...” – nareszcie po 123 latach okupacji rodacy mogli swobodnie, bez strachu śpiewać pieśni patriotyczne, wyrażać swoją radość z odzyskania niepodległości. **Czy Polacy dzisiaj pamiętają o tym święcie? 11 listopada 1918 roku to jedna z najważniejszych dat w historii Polski.**

Kiedy w 1914 roku wybuchła I wojna światowa, Polacy ujrzeni w tym szansę na uwolnienie się spod jarzma okupantów. W wojnie brali bowiem udział trzej okupanci – Niemcy, Rosja i Austro-Węgry. W przypadku ich porażki, na europejskiej scenie politycznej można było nareszcie skutecznie poruszyć kłopotliwą sprawę polską. Tak też się stało. Dzień zakończenia wojny – 11 listopada 1918 roku okazał się szczęśliwy dla narodu polskiego. Kraj był niezwykle wyniszczony, okupanci wycofując się z ziem polskich, nierzadko zostawiali za sobą spaloną ziemię. Niezliczona ilość dzieł sztuki, ikon artystycznych, surowców została zagarnięta i wywieziona z Polski. Nowo powstałe państwo, musiało poradzić sobie nie tylko z

klęską gospodarczą, ale trudną sytuacją polityczną. W nocy z 6 na 7 listopada 1918 roku powstał pierwszy historyczny Tymczasowy Rząd Republiki Polskiej w Lublinie z Ignacym Daszyńskim na czele. 11 listopada Rada Regencyjna przekazała Piłsudskiemu naczelne dowództwo nad siłami zbrojnymi, a 14 listopada otrzymał także władzę cywilną. Dwa dni później, 16 listopada Piłsudski wystąpił komunikat do państw Ententy, informując, że „z woli całego narodu” powstało państwo polskie, obejmujące wszystkie wyzwolone ziemie. Nastroje na ziemiach polskich w listopadzie 1918 roku były niezwykle optymistyczne. Ludzie budzili się jakby do życia, początkowo wciąż nie wierząc, że odzyskali wolność.

11 listopada jest uroczystością obchodzoną na terenie całego kraju. Tego dnia Polacy jednoczą się i wspólnie upamiętniają historyczne wydarzenie, oddają cześć rodakom, którzy zginęli walcząc o wolną Polskę. „Trzecia Rzeczpospolita ma może swoje wady, ale jest naszym państwem, Polską niepodległą” – mówił prezydent Polski Kaczyński, podczas obchodów 90 rocznicy odzyskania niepodległości w 2008 roku.

„Cokolwiek będzie, cokolwiek się stanie, Jedno wiem tylko: sprawiedliwość będzie, Jedno wiem tylko: Polska zmartwychwstanie.”- mówił kiedyś Zygmunt Krasiński. I Polska zmartwychwstała. Może nie wielka, ciągle z problemami, ale nasza. Polacy z biegiem lat nie zapominają o swojej historii, korzeniach. Nadal w przeważającym procentem jesteśmy narodem patriotów. **Nie można nie wspomnieć tutaj o Polonii zamieszkałej w zasadzie wszystkie zakątki globu Polscy emigranci od dziesięcioleci szerzyli duch polskości w innych krajach, uświadamiali inne narody o istnieniu Polski, promowali polskie tradycje. Tak było przed odzyskaniem niepodległości, po wojnach, w czasach PRL-u, tak jest i dziś.**

Dzięki hartowi ducha naszych przodków możemy bez cienia lęku śpiewać hymn Polski i Rotę Marii Konopnickiej. Wkrótce we wszystkich miastach i wioskach załomoczą biało-czerwone flagi, a w sercach poczujemy ukłucie. Tak, jesteśmy Polakami! Mamy swój kraj. Słowa Roty powstałej na wskutek oburzenia prześladowaniem Polaków pod zaborem pruskim sprawdziły się: **Odzyska ziemi dziadów wnuk! Tak nam dopomóż Bóg!**
