## RCIA

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) is the process by which individuals who are not baptized or are baptized in another Christian church or have been baptized Catholic but never received any of the other Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist) may become full members of the Catholic Church. The 2014-2015 RCIA Program will begin on Sunday, December 7, 2014; will meet weekly on Sundays at 10:00 AM for classes and 11:30 AM for Mass; and will end with the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil on Saturday, April 4, 2015.

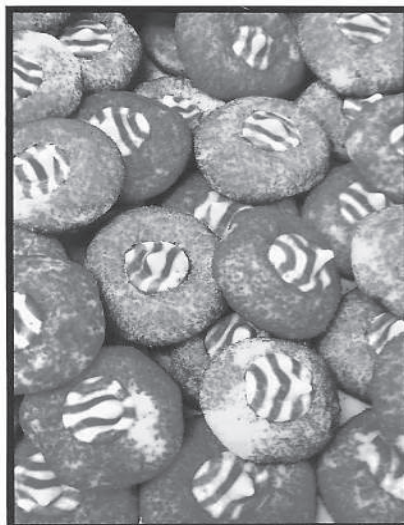
The bakers of our parish are planning to have the annual Christmas Cookie fund raiser/sale in the lower level of the Social Center from 12 Noon until 6 PM.

### **Maria Simma o kontaktach z duszami czyścowymi - cz. II**

Maria Simma bardzo mocno podkreśla fakt, że **Pan Bóg zdecydowanie zabrania ludziom żyjącym na ziemi wzywania czy wywoływania dusz zmarłych**. Ona nigdy nie wzywała żadnej duszy, przychodziły do niej tylko za pozwoleniem Bożym. Nigdy nie było to z jej inicjatywy, ani nigdy tego nie pragnęła. W czasie wywoływania duchów szatan podszycia się pod dusze zmarłych, aby kłamać i utwierdzać ludzi w kłamstwie.

Maria mówi, że **grzechy, które zadają najwięcej bólu w czyścicu to grzechy przeciwko miłości bliźniego**, szczególnie brak przebaczenia, nieczystość, zatwardziałość serca, wrogość. Grzechy braku przebaczenia, obmowy i oszczerstwa wymagają wyjątkowo bolesnego i długiego przewycięzania ich konsekwencji. Daje przykład pewnej kobiety, która po śmierci odwiedzając Marię powiedziała, że powodem jej cierpienia jest fakt, że przez wiele lat podtrzymywała w sobie wielką niechęć do swojej przyjaciółki, z którą nie chciała się pojednać, chociaż tamta wielokrotnie takie próby podejmowała. Nawet na łożu śmierci nie przebaczyła i się nie pogodziła.

Maria podkreślała, że najgorszą pułapką dla ludzi pobożnych jest **pycha**. Pewna kobieta zmarła, gdy poddawała się aborcji, ale przed śmiercią żałowała i była bardzo pokorna, natomiast pewien mężczyzna, chociaż często chodził do Kościoła, to jednak wszystkich krytykował i gardził innymi. Dlatego dłużej musiał cierpieć w czyścicu aniżeli ta kobieta. **Najpotężniejszą bronią przeciwko grzechowi i zakusom diabła jest pokora**. Maria daje przykład matki czworga dzieci, która, kiedy dowiedziała się, że wkrótce umrze, nie buntowała się, ale całkowicie zaufała Bogu i powierzyła Mu siebie, a troskę o swoje dzieci złożyła w Jego ręce. Jej bezgraniczne zaufanie Bogu sprawiło, że poszła prosto do nieba.

Maria Simma przestrzega przed zboczeniami seksualnymi, a szczególnie przed praktykami homoseksualnymi, gdyż pochodzą one z inspiracji Szatana. Wielką winę ponoszą ci, którzy im ulegają twierdząc, że takimi się urodzili i mają do nich pełne prawo.

Maria z własnego doświadczenia wie, że **najskuteczniejszym sposobem pomocy duszom czyścowym w zmniejszeniu ich cierpienia, a w końcu w wyzwoleniu ich z czyścica, jest Msza św. odprawiana w ich intencji**. Jest to dla nich najwspanialszy dar, bo w czasie Mszy św. zostaje uobecniona ofiara krzyżowa Chrystusa i Jego ostateczne zwycięstwo nad grzechem i śmiercią w Zmartwychwstaniu.

Bardzo ważną pomocą dla dusz czyścowych jest ofiara złożona z naszego cierpienia, choroby, pokuty, postu oraz każdej formy modlitwy, szczególnie różańcowej oraz drogi krzyżowej. Cierpiący w czyścicu potrzebują naszej pomocy, ponieważ sami już nie mogą naprawić zła, które popełnili w czasie ziemskiego życia. Dopóki żyjemy na ziemi posiadamy możliwość naprawienia zła, nie tylko tego, które sami spowodowaliśmy, ale również tego, które popełnili nasi zmarli. Dusze czyścowe, powiedziały Marii, że **życie człowieka na ziemi jest tylko jedno i jest niepowtarzalne**. Dlatego reinkarnacja jest wymysłem szatana, który pragnie ludzi wprowadzać w błąd i odciągać ich od Boga. Reinkarnację trzeba więc traktować jako diabelski trick i podstępny pokusę ojca kłamstwa.

***Dotychczas, pomimo podejmowania takich prób, nikomu nie udało się dowieść, że Maria Simma i jej kierownik duchowy dopuścili się oszustwa, a fakty opisane zostały wymyślone.***

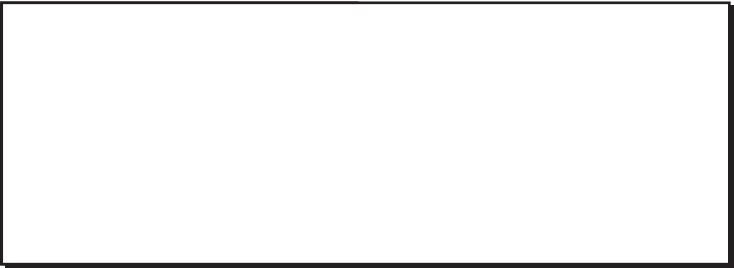

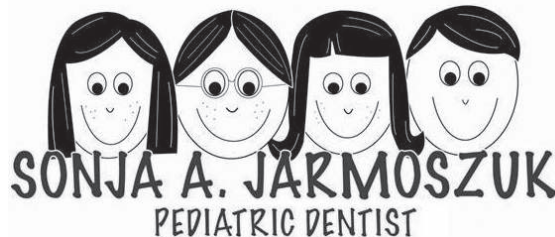
