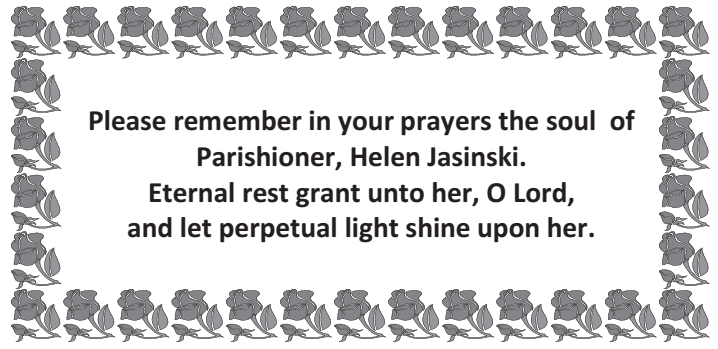
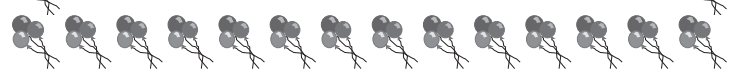

As a next step, we would like to put together a Faithful Legacy dinner meeting on a weekday evening to offer discussion and information about how to make a designated gift to St. Stanislaus parish as part of your estate planning. We would like to coordinate it so we can have an attorney from the diocese present to cover some legal topics of interest for you to consider when creating your final directives. The attorney would also be able to answer any legal questions that might arise. In addition, we would hope to have an individual from the insurance industry present to answer questions about making an insurance policy a part of your estate plan. Other related topics will also be covered.

As you can imagine, to set up a dinner meeting like this requires us to see if there is sufficient interest within the parish for an event of this type. Therefore we are asking those who are interested to contact the rectory, (216) 341-9091, during normal business hours and ask Dan Kane to enter your name and number of guests on the list of those wishing to attend such a function. **Please notify Dan Kane no later than January 23, 2015.**

The level of parishioner response will determine how we will proceed with this event.

Od drugiego czerwca biuro parafialne rozpoczęło przyjmowanie intencji mszalnych na rok 2015. Pracujący w biurze przyjmują intencje mszalne w kolejności ich zamawiania. KOLEDY!!!!

UROCZYSTOŚĆ OBJAWIENIA PAŃSKIEGO - święto wiary



Pokłon Mędrców ze Wschodu złożony Dzieciątku Jezus, opisywany w Ewangelii przez św. Mateusza (Mt 2, 1-12), symbolizuje pokłon świata pogan, wszystkich ludzi, którzy klękają przed Bogiem Wcielonym. Święto Bożego Narodzenia koncentruje się na uniżeniu Syna Bożego podkreślając ziemskie narodziny Słowa Bożego. Epifania (z gr. objawienie) akcentuje Boską wielkość nowo narodzonego, który pragnie swą miłością zbawczą ogarnąć nie tylko naród wybrany, ale wszystkich ludzi.

Uroczystość Objawienia Pańskiego zwana jest popularnie Świętem Trzech Króli. Kluczem do zrozumienia tego święta jest jedynie 2 rozdział Ewangelii św. Mateusza, który mówi o Mędrcach przybywających do Betlejem, aby złożyć hołd Jezusowi. Mędrców nazywa się Królami w związku z prorocत्वami Starego Testamentu. Wymienia się ich najczęściej trzech ze względu na trzy dary o których wspomina Ewangelia i których symbolikę wyjaśnił w II w. św. Ireneusz z Lyonu: złoto ofiarowane Jezusowi jako królowi, kadzidło jako Bogu i mirrę jako człowiekowi zapowiadającą Jego śmierć. W ikonografii chrześcijańskiej można jednak spotkać czterech, sześciu, a nawet dwunastu mędrców. Dopiero od wieku VIII pojawiają się imiona Trzech Magów: Kacper, Melchior i Baltazar. Są one zupełnie dowolne, nie potwierdzone niczym.

Według relacji Ewangelisty, że Herod kazał wymordować dzieci do dwóch lat, wynika, iż Magowie przybyli do Betlejem, kiedy Chrystus miał co najmniej kilka miesięcy, a może nawet ponad rok. Magowie nie zastali Jezusa w stajni; św. Mateusz pisze wyraźnie, że gwiazda stanęła nad "domem". Było w nim jednak bardzo ubogo. A jednak Mędrcy "upadli przed Nim na twarz i oddali Mu pokłon". Padano na twarz w owych czasach tylko przed władcami albo w świątyni przed bóstwami. Magowie byli przekonani, że Dziecię jest przyszłym królem Izraela. Według podania, które jednak trudno potwierdzić historycznie, Magowie mieli powrócić do swojej krainy, a kiedy jeden z Apostołów głosił tam Ewangelię, mieli przyjąć chrzest. Legenda głosi, że nawet zostali wyświęceni na biskupów i mieli ponieść śmierć męczeńską.

Z uroczystością Objawienia Pańskiego wiąże się zwyczaj święcenia kredy, kadzidła i wody. Poświęconą kredą wypisuje się na drzwiach mieszkania K+M+B oraz aktualny rok na znak wiary, że mieszkający w nich chrześcijanie na wzór Mędrców przyjęli narodzonego Jezusa jako swojego Boga i Króla. Zwyczaj ten nawiązuje także do Księgi Wyjścia, która mówi, że Izraelici znaczyli drzwi i progi domów krwią baranka, aby Pan nie pozwolił wejść niszczycielowi do wnętrza.. Litery te, interpretuje się jako inicjały trzech króli. W średniowieczu odczytywano to inaczej. Napis "C+M+B" (imię Kacper po łacinie pisane jest przez C) wyrażał błogostawieństwo: Niech Chrystus błogostawi mieszkanie! (Christus mansionem benedictat). Dom kropi się wodą święconą, a spalane kadzidło podkreśla, że jest on miejscem modlitwy.

Uroczystość Objawienia Pańskiego uczy, że chrześcijanie, podobnie jak mędrcy, którzy powrócili do domu inną drogą, winni po spotkaniu Zbawiciela rozpocząć nowe życie; doświadczywszy Jego miłującej obecności w sposób mądry objawiać ją światu. Jak mędrcy winni składać duchowe dary: złota swej ludzkiej wolności, kadzidła codziennej modlitwy oraz mirry – czyli trudu bycia na co dzień dla Boga. Na tej drodze towarzyszy wszystkim poszukującym Słowo Boże, porównywane przez Ojców Kościoła do blasku gwiazdy prowadzącej do poznania prawdy.

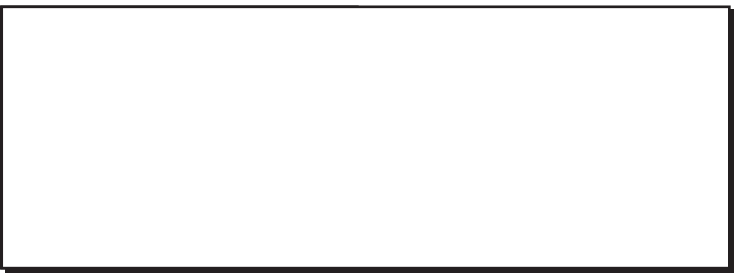

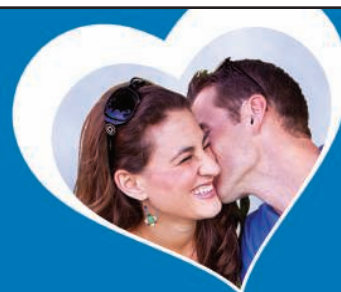
