**NEW THIRD THURSDAY EVENING MASS INTENTION**

With the recent canonization of St. John Paul II (this past Divine Mercy Sunday) and over a half a year of Masses of Thanksgiving for that blessed event, it now seems the time has arrived to advance to directing our focus and prayers toward the numerous other potential causes for sainthood which wait for further confirmation and miracles, answers to the intercessions as we so clearly saw with the intercessory power via St. John Paul II.

This having been said, we have proposed this first "Third Thursday" evening Mass of 2015 to be offered for the canonization of the Eleven Sisters of the Holy Family of Nazareth from Nowogrodek. In this, "The Year of Consecrated Life" as deemed by Pope Francis, it seemed only appropriate to begin our monthly Mass dedicated to this cause. We will continue to pray for this intention for subsequent months while we ask our parishioners to offer other suggestions for our prayerful focus at future "Third Thursday" evening Masses. There are many "Servants of God", "Venerables" and "Blesseds" simply waiting for their official recognition as "Saints" of the Church as the process of the occurrence as well as confirmation of miracles allows them to be so called. Please let us know your suggestions and we will include them in our list of Third Thursday Evening Canonization Masses accordingly. It worked with St. John Paul II!!! Remember, they are our friends and are eager to intercede on our behalf. Prayer is powerful!

To those unfamiliar with the Eleven Sisters (pictured above in a painting by famed Polish artist, Jan Styka), their story of quiet love and heroism is noteworthy. Their martyrdom was the "fruit" of the tragedy which befell their part of Europe during World War II. Nowogrodek, then in territory deemed Polish after the Commonwealth of Poland-Lithuania as well as the post partitioned lands after the Treaty of Versailles, the lands fell victim to the armies of both the totalitarian regimes of Nazi Germany and Soviet Russia during the great war. Having survived the humiliation of the Soviet invasion of 1939 the sisters were then exposed to the horrors of the Nazis following Hitler's occupation of their city in 1942. Their extermination was necessary in keeping with the goals of that regime as well, thus, on the early morning hours of August 1, 1943, the Eleven Sisters were trucked off to a site in the nearby forest, executed, and buried in a mass grave. To the forces of evil: problem solved... To the forces of good: acts of love. Now we can ask for their intercession as we pray for their help and the consequent elevation to the rank of sainthood. Please join us this Thursday at 7 PM as we remember and honor these twelve brave women and hear more of their love story!

### **Z chrztaami jak z kredytem: wszyscy chcą, ale ilu oddaje?**

Kiedy ślepy prowadzi kulawego nie trudno jest przewidzieć, że nie uda im się dojść do wyznaczonego celu. Kiedy zawierzasz swoje sprawy osobom nie odpowiedzialnym, nie możesz winić tylko innych za to, że nie udało ci się osiągnąć tego, co zamierzałeś.

Niedziela chrztu św. Pan Jezus już JAKO dorosły przyjmuje chrzest. Zaczyna się droga głoszenia Ewangelii. Okres zwykły w Kościele też. Jesteśmy ochrzczeni. Dziś przyjmują dzieci. Zaczyna się droga życia nigdy / czasem / często obok Ewangelii. Niepotrzebne skreślić. Prosząc o chrzest dla dziecka przyjmujecie obowiązek wychowania go w wierze aby przyjmując Boże przykazania miłowało Boga i bliźniego jak nas nauczył Jezus Chrystus. Nauka wiary: jak wychodzi, ile razy przypominamy sobie katechizm, czytamy Pismo Św.? Modlimy się wspólnie w domu? Znamy przykazania? Aktywnie podchodzimy do wiary? Rozmawiamy o wierze? Żyjemy Kościołem. Uczciwość od początku. Bywa dziś już bardzo różnie. Chrzest i..... I Komunia. Istnieje dylemat

chrzczyć / nie chrzczyć, ale w wywiadzie jeden z egzorcystów stwierdził, że chrzest jest darem chroniącym przed działaniem Zła, sam w sobie powoduje że zło ma mniejszy przystęp do człowieka samo z siebie. Oczywiście o ile człowiek sam na to zło się nie otwiera. I rola wychowania. Dziś pojawiają się sytuacje gdy ci ochrzczeni chcą się wypisać z Kościoła i wytrzeć znamię chrztu. Dlaczego nie mają wiary? Nie poznali Jezusa? Nie pokochali Go? Co się stało w tym domu? Zostaje zatem pytanie chrzest i co dalej?... Jaki przykład i duch Ewangelii jest w domu. Nie na pokaz czy moment kołedy, ale na co dzień? Chrzest nie jest czynnością magiczną: on zatapia nas w męce i śmierci Jezusa. Wzywa do naśladowania. Otwiera na dar odkupienia. Wydaje się że chrześcijaństwo przeżywa kryzys. Kościół jako dom też. Wynikiem może tego, że wiara staje się mniej lub bardziej towarem a nie miłością a religia sposobem na życie i kolejnym światopoglądem. A może tylko potrzebą? Kryzys modne słowo. Słyszymy w 2 czytaniu: bój się Boga i postępuj sprawiedliwie a dzisiejszy człowiek czy boi się Boga? Czy bój się Boga dziś jeszcze działa? Dziś ludzie boją się kryzysu, choroby, wpadki, kary pieniężnej czy więzienia, ale czy Boga? Wygoda. Brak odpowiedzialności i spychanie na innych. Przywileje tak, ale obowiązki nie. Instrumentalizm. Psychologia. Minimalizm. Pretensje. Nieczyste intencje. A może zapominamy, że za mną idzie mocniejszy ode mnie. Ja muszę o tym pamiętać, ale i ci ku którym wychodzę. Ale kiedy mówię, że ta modlitwa działa: Usłyszałem ale chwalił się. Ale czasy. Gdzie miejsce dla Boga? Dla wiary? Kryzys chyba i na tej płaszczyźnie jest. Jak w świecie. I te same przyczyny i skutki. Aha... Słyszałem opinie że księża nie podają recepty na kryzys. Dlaczego się wziął i co zrobić by minął. Podają ale nikt nie słucha. Kościół z doświadczenia wiary to wie. W działaniach i słabościach ludzi ciągle się o to potyka i sam: Skąd się wziął kryzys?: 7 grzechów głównych: pycha, chciwość, nieczystość, zazdrość, nieumiarkowanie, gniew, lenistwo. Bo te zawirowania wzięły się z tej zachłanności, nieuczciwości, nieumiarkowania, lenistwa. Mieć, dać za wszelką cenę. Jak zaradzić, bo wzywa się duchownych również do rad. Łatwo i trudno. Pozbyć się ich: tych grzechów głównych. Będzie mniej lęku, strachu, paniki, poczucia straty i bólu niepewności. Ale kto chce rezygnować z nadmiaru, kto chce stracić, oddać, poświęcić? Pomyśleć z poświęceniem o innych. To może myśli dla wielkich tego świata. Ale i do nas. Skoro sami mówimy, że mamy XXI wiek i wszystko jest dla ludzi. I ciągle mało. Zresztą jakie grzechy główne? Co to takiego? Znamy je? Może zatem dziś choć jeden rozdział katechizmu KKK. 1212 – 1284. Jaka jest moja odpowiedzialność za życie Kościoła? I jak się wywiązuję ze swoich obowiązków wiary? Wierzę, to znaczy?... I może nikt z nas nie jest winny, że jest kryzys na świecie, ale pytanie w tym miejscu, czy ja – moim świadectwem życia – nie dokładam się do kryzysu Kościoła?


