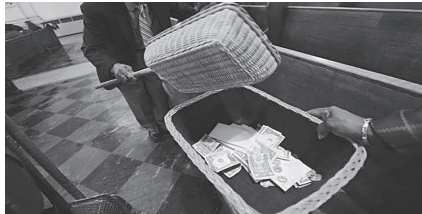

**Pope Francis' Appeal:** 13. The urgent challenge to protect our common home includes a concern to bring the whole human family together to seek a sustainable and integral development, for we know that things can change. The Creator does not abandon us; he never forsakes his loving plan or repents of having created us. Humanity still has the ability to work together in building our common home. Here I want to recognize, encourage and thank all those striving in countless ways to guarantee the protection of the home which we share. Particular appreciation is owed to those who tirelessly seek to resolve the tragic effects of environmental degradation on the lives of the world's poorest. Young people demand change. They wonder how anyone can claim to be building a better future without thinking of the environmental crisis and the sufferings of the excluded. 14. I urgently appeal, then, for a new dialogue about how we are shaping the future of our planet. We need a conversation which includes everyone, since the environmental challenge we are undergoing, and its human roots, concern and affect us all. The worldwide ecological movement has already made considerable progress and led to the establishment of numerous organizations committed to raising awareness of these challenges. Regrettably, many efforts to seek concrete solutions to the environmental crisis have proved ineffective, not only because of powerful opposition but also because of a more general lack of interest. Obstructionist attitudes, even on the part of believers, can range from denial of the problem to indifference, nonchalant resignation or blind confidence in technical solutions. We require a new and universal solidarity. As the bishops of Southern Africa have stated: "Everyone's talents and involvement are needed to redress the damage caused by human abuse of God's creation". [22] All of us can cooperate as instruments of God for the care of creation, each according to his or her own culture, experience, involvements and talents.

15. It is my hope that this Encyclical Letter, which is now added to the body of the Church's social teaching, can help us to acknowledge the appeal, immensity and urgency of the challenge we face. I will begin by briefly reviewing several aspects of the present ecological crisis, with the aim of drawing on the results of the best scientific research available today, letting them touch us deeply and provide a concrete foundation for the ethical and spiritual itinerary that follows. I will then consider some principles drawn from the Judaeo-Christian tradition which can render our commitment to the environment more coherent. I will then attempt to get to the roots of the present situation, so as to consider not only its symptoms but also its deepest causes. This will help to provide an approach to ecology which respects our unique place as human beings in this world and our relationship to our surroundings. In light of this reflection, I will advance some broader proposals for dialogue and action which would involve each of us as individuals, and also affect international policy. Finally, convinced as I am that change is impossible without motivation and a process of education, I will offer some inspired guidelines for human development to be found in the treasure of Christian spiritual experience.

## POSTAWY W CZASIE MSZY ŚWIETEJ cz.2

### Postawa siedząca

Pozycja siedząca według starożytnego zwyczaju przysługiwała urzędnikom, nauczycielom i sędziom jako znak władzy i godności (Ps 106,32; Mt 19,28; Łk 4,20). Sam Chrystus siedząc nauczał w świątyni jerozolimskiej: Łk 2,46. Biskup zasiadał na swojej katedrze i z niej nauczał oraz przewodniczył liturgii. Podobnie czynił prezbiter. Sprawując sakrament pokuty kapłan zajmuje pozycję siedzącą na znak powagi urzędu sędziowskiego. Władzę sędziowską kapłan wykonuje w imieniu i w obecności Chrystusa.

Wierni w kościele nie zawsze siedzieli. Przez całe wieki w kościołach nie było ławek. W średniowieczu podczas długich nabożeństw wierni wspierali się na laskach różnego kształtu. Miejsca siedzące przewidziane były tylko dla duchowieństwa (stalle, sedilia). Siedzenia dla wiernych wprowadzili dopiero protestanci w swoich kościołach. Za ich przykładem poszli katolicy najpierw w krajach, w których było dużo protestantów, a później w całym Kościele powszechnym. Do ławek kościelnych katolicy dodali klęczniki.

Siedzenie jest także postawą słuchającego ucznia. Jest znakiem skupienia, przyjmowania i rozważania Słowa Bożego.

W którym momencie siedzisz w czasie liturgii Mszy św.?

- podczas czytań mszalnych (z wyjątkiem Ewangelii), psalmu responsoryjnego i kazania (homilii) oraz ciszy po kazaniu
- podczas przygotowania darów ofiarnych
- podczas chwili ciszy po Komunii św.
- w czasie ogłoszeń parafialnych

Jest więc ta postawa na pierwszym miejscu wyrazem zaśłuchania. Wygodna pozycja ciała sprzyja dłuższemu słuchaniu słowa, pomaga w jego przyjmowaniu i rozważaniu. Wyraża ona gotowość przyjęcia przesłania, z jakim ktoś wobec nas występuje.

Warto też zauważyć, że postawa siedząca jest znakiem zażyłości między osobami – nie przy wszystkich ważnych gościach możemy siedzieć. W Ewangelii według świętego Jana Chrystusa mówi: „Już was nie nazywam sługami, bo sługa nie wie, co czyni pan jego, ale nazwałem was przyjaciółmi, albowiem oznajmiłem wam wszystko, co usłyszałem od Ojca mego” (J 15, 15). Jezus zaprasza nas, byśmy zasiedli razem z Nim do stołu Jego Słowa oraz Ciała i Krwi. Słuchając słowa Pana podobnie jak ewangeliczne tłumy przyjmujemy orędzie zbawienia, a posiliwszy się przy stole Eucharystii, trwamy w Bożej obecności, którą zapowiadało m.in. cudowne rozmnożenie chleba i nakarmienie zgłodniałych (por. J 6, 10). Trzeba na koniec dodać, że istotna w zgromadzeniu liturgicznym jest jedność przyjmowanych postaw, która jest uzewnętrznieniem pragnienia rzeczywistej i głębszej jedności z braćmi i siostrami. Gdy więc znajdujemy się w nowym miejscu, nowych okolicznościach, gdzie mogą panować inne, uprawnione tradycje warto mieć to na uwadze!


