III. THE MYSTERY OF THE UNIVERSE

81. Human beings, even if we postulate a process of evolution, also possess a uniqueness which cannot be fully explained by the evolution of other open systems. Each of us has his or her own personal identity and is capable of entering into dialogue with others and with God himself. Our capacity to reason, to develop arguments, to be inventive, to interpret reality and to create art, along with other not yet discovered capacities, are signs of a uniqueness which transcends the spheres of physics and biology. The sheer novelty involved in the emergence of a personal being within a material universe presupposes a direct action of God and a particular call to life and to relationship on the part of a "Thou" who addresses himself to another "thou". The biblical accounts of creation invite us to see each human being as a subject who can never be reduced to the status of an object.

82. Yet it would also be mistaken to view other living beings as mere objects subjected to arbitrary human domination. When nature is viewed solely as a source of profit and gain, this has serious consequences for society. This vision of "might is right" has engendered immense inequality, injustice and acts of violence against the majority of humanity, since resources end up in the hands of the first comer or the most powerful: the winner takes all. Completely at odds with this model are the ideals of harmony, justice, fraternity and peace as proposed by Jesus. As he said of the powers of his own age: "You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great men exercise authority over them. It shall not be so among you; but whoever would be great among you must be your servant" (Mt 20:25-26).

83. The ultimate destiny of the universe is in the fullness of God, which has already been attained by the risen Christ, the measure of the maturity of all things.[53] Here we can add yet another argument for rejecting every tyrannical and irresponsible domination of human beings over other creatures. The ultimate purpose of other creatures is not to be found in us. Rather, all creatures are moving forward with us and through us towards a common point of arrival, which is God, in that transcendent fullness where the risen Christ embraces and illumines all things. Human beings, endowed with intelligence and love, and drawn by the fullness of Christ, are called to lead all creatures back to their Creator.

ROK MIŁOSIERDZIA BOZEGO

Od 8 grudnia 2015 r. do 20 listopada 2016 r. potrwa w Kościele katolickim Nadzwyczajny Jubileusz Miłosierdzia Bożego. Zapowiedział to Ojciec Święty Franciszek w trakcie nabożeństwa pokutnego, któremu przewodniczył 13 marca w Bazylice św. Piotra w Watykanie. - *Drodzy bracia i siostry, często myślałem o tym, jak Kościół może uczynić jeszcze bardziej oczywistym swe posłannictwo bycia świadkiem miłosierdzia. Jest to droga, która rozpoczyna się od nawrócenia duchowego. I dlatego postanowiłem ogłosić Jubileusz Nadzwyczajny, którego ośrodkiem będzie Miłosierdzie Boże. Będzie to Rok Święty Miłosierdzia. Chcemy przeżywać go w świetle słów Pana: «Bądźcie miłosierni jak Ojciec wasz jest miłosierny» (Łk 6, 36) - powiedział papież.*

Rok Miłosierdzia rozpocznie się otwarciem Drzwi Świętych w Bazylice św. Piotra w uroczystość Niepokalanego Poczęcia Najświętszej Maryi Panny (8 grudnia) br. a zakończy w Niedzielę Chrystusa Króla Wszechświata - 20 listopada 2016 r. Drzwi Święte (istniejące w rzymskich Bazylikach: św. Piotra, św. Jana na Lateranie, św. Pawła za Murami i św. Matki Bożej Większej) są otwierane tylko na czas Roku Świętego, a w normalnym okresie pozostają zamurowane. Ich otwarcie (najpierw w Bazylice św. Piotra, a potem w pozostałych) wyraża symbolicznie ideę otwarcia dla wszystkich wierzących tego szczególnego przejścia na stronę zbawienia.

W Roku Jubileuszowym nie chodzi o to, by teoretycznie rozważać co to jest miłosierdzie i je definiować, ale o to, by je przeżyć. W orędziu na Wielki Post Franciszek posługiwał się obrazem Jezusa, który umywa nogi uczniom i bardzo mocno podkreśla, że to nie jest tylko przykład: ot, jednorazowo Jezus dał nam przykład umywania nóg. Tylko papież mówi, że chodzi o doświadczenie ciągłe i aktualne. Bóg wybacza w ten sposób, że czyni to za cenę śmierci własnego Syna. To jest istota ewangelizacji, najbardziej elementarne orędzie. Na wszystko inne będzie czas później. Papież Franciszek wielokrotnie mówił o miłosierdziu, ten temat jest mu szczególnie bliski. Usłyszenie słowa miłosierdzie zmienia wszystko. To najlepsze, co możemy usłyszeć: że zmienia świat. Odrobina miłosierdzia czyni świat mniej zimnym i bardziej sprawiedliwym. Musimy zrozumieć dobrze to miłosierdzie Boga, tego miłosiernego Ojca, który ma tak wiele cierpliwości - przekonywał Ojciec Święty Franciszek w rozważaniach podczas modlitwy Anioł Pański 17 marca 2013 r. Natomiast 11 stycznia br. podczas modlitwy Anioł Pański Franciszek mówił: - Potrzeba dziś miłosierdzia i istotne jest, aby wierni świeccy żyli nim i zanieśli je do różnych sfer społecznych. Naprzód! Przeżywamy czas miłosierdzia, to jest właśnie czas miłosierdzia.

MODLITWA NA ROK MIŁOSIERDZIA

Panie Jezu Chryste, Ty nauczyłeś nas, abyśmy byli miłosierni, jak Ojciec nasz niebieski i powiedziałaś nam, że kto widzi Ciebie, widzi także i Jęgo. Ukaż nam Twoje oblicze, a będziemy zbawieni. Twój wzrok pełen miłości uwolnił Zacheusza oraz Mateusza od niewoli pieniądza, a nierządnicę i Magdalenę od szukania szczęścia wyłącznie w rzeczach stworzonych. Wzrok ten sprawił, że Piotr zapłakał po zdradzie, a żałujący Dobry Łotr usłyszał zapewnienie o Raju. Pozwól nam tak wysłuchać słów, które wypowiedziałaś do Samarytanki, jakbyś je wypowiedziała do każdego nas: O, gdybyś znała dar Boży! Ty, który jesteś Obliczem widzialnym Ojca niewidzialnego, Boga, który objawia swoją wszechmoc przede wszystkim przez przebaczenie i miłosierdzie: spraw, aby Kościół na świecie stał się widzialnym obliczem Ciebie, swojego Pana zmartwychwstałego i uwielbionego. Ty zechciałeś również, aby Twoi słudzy przybrani byli w słabość po to, aby mogli okazywać słuszne współczucie tym, którzy trwają w niewiedzy i błędzie: niech każda osoba, która się do nich zwraca, czuje się oczekiwana, kochana oraz doświadcza przebaczenia od Boga. Poślij Twojego Ducha i uświęć wszystkich nas Jęgo namaszczeniem, aby Jubileusz Miłosierdzia był rokiem łaski od Pana, a Twój Kościół z odnowionym entuzjazmem mógł nieść dobrą nowinę ubogim, głosić wolność więźniom i uciśnionym oraz przywracać wzrok niewidomym. Prosimy o to za wstawiennictwem Maryi, Matki Miłosierdzia, Ciebie, który z Ojcem i Duchem Świętym żyjesz i królujesz na wieki wieków. Amen
