IL POVERELLO INCLUDES NARRATED FIRST HAND ACCOUNTS OF FRANCIS' EXPERIENCES AND LIGHT HEARTED LEGENDS OF THE SAINTS DEEDS AND MIRACLES. THE AUDIENCE IS FURTHER TREATED BY THE APPEARANCE OF SEVERAL ANTIQUE INSTRUMENTS: HARP, HURDY-GURDY, FRAME DRUM, RE-CORDER, DUMBK (GOBLET DRUM), 'UD (MIDDLE EASTERN LUTE) AND RIIQQ (EGYPTIAN TAMBOURINE), VIELLE AND REBEC (MEDIEVAL FIDDLES).
